Acadia Seminary.

The last days of the term are devoted to written examinations and preparations for the Saturday evening's Recital and the closing exercises.

The whole number in attendance has been 114 of which 63 were boarding pupils. Forty-eight pupils have attended from the village and vicinity.

The present Junior class, numbering 15, is the largest in the history of the school. Eight of these will graduate in piano, having completed three years under the instruction of Fraulein Suck.

The classes in Drawing and Painting have been unusually large, and more excellent work from Still Life, Casts and Models has been done than perhaps ever before.

It is hoped that the friends and appreciators of Art will avail themselves of the opportunity afforded on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday to visit the Studio and see what excellent work has been done.

At the same time an exhibition of literary work will be held, where the friends of the school can examine the character of the work done in several of the sciences and mathematics.

The school has also been blessed in a spiritual way, and six young ladies have taken a decided stand for in the Christian life. One of the graduates is a member of the Missionary Volunteer Band, and after further preparation in a school of Christian Workers, hopes to open the foreign field. The representatives of the Seminary in India already number eight.

What school, in existence but fifteen years, can show a like record? Let the friends of Acadia Seminary thank God and take courage.
