I had overboard and lightened her all we could and at the turn of the tide she floated. In fifteen minutes the sails blew off her, but though it was as dark as the proverbial black cat I brought her down to a more sheltered place. We did this by sheer guess work as we could not see our hands before us. I now saw that the vessel was dreadfully strained and feared she would go to pieces our feet and had as it was we might have a better chance to try to get home in the boat. I can tell you it was a desperate chance, eight men in a small leaky dory, with such a sea running, and the night so dark. It was however our last chance. I put the Capt. into the boat between my feet and took the oars myself, as I was afraid to trust anyone else. I got another oar from the schooner and gave it to my brother whom I placed in the stern to steer, as well as he could and the remainder of the men were piled on top of each other in the bottom of the boat. I shall never forget that trip. A hundred times I thought we were swamped before we got to the breakers at all. After a long pull we struck the breakers. You know there are generally three seas in the runs, and to get swamped between them meant sure death in the undertow. I watched one sea and running in on top of the first wave, I quickly backed the cory with the oars to catch the last sea. I shall never forget how she trembled on the rise, and for a second stood perfectly still, but with God's help I had done the trick, and the sea that we rode on threw us on the crest of a giant breaker which carried us along as rapidly as a toboggan going down a chute. When she rose I saw that she was going to fall over and I shall never forget that moment if I live to be a hundred years, as I sang out to all hands to look out and the next moment the dory dipped by the head and fifty feet in the air turned a complete summersault throwing all hands fully twenty feet up on the beach. I fell on my hands and knees and after a minute looked around for the others and heard the Captain groaning. I picked him up and found that he had broken his leg at the thigh, so we had to carry him on our backs to my house where I set his leg as best I could, and he remained with me until he was able to go home. We were all more or less bruised, but thankful it was so worse. Next morning there was no "Sea-Flower," she had gone to pieces in the night.

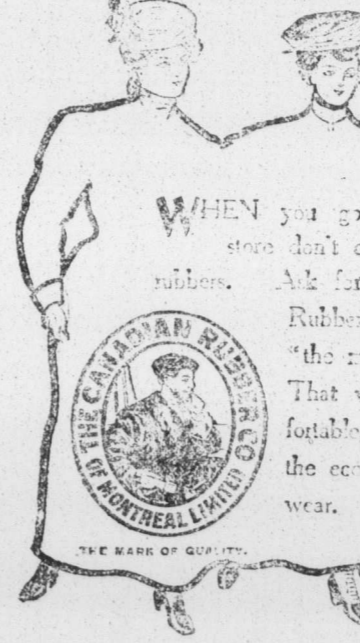

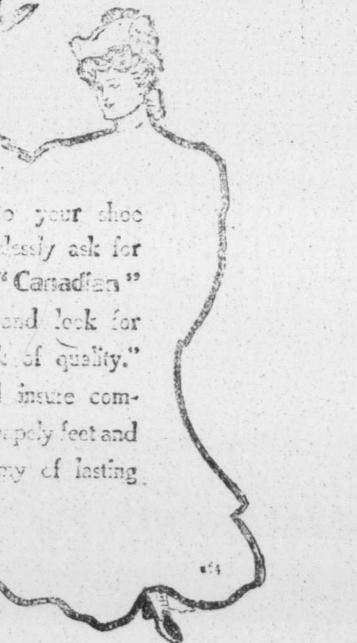
