## Notes From Harbor Grace.

News was received in town this morning of the death at St. John's of our old citizen, Mr. Stephen Butt. Mr. Butt was receiving treatment at the institution for the insane, and he died there this morning. The body will arrive by this evening's train. He leaves besides a wife, three sons and three daughters to mourn their loss.

Mr. I. Strowbridge, the popular C. of E. teacher of Island Cove, was in town to-day on a visit.

Mr. R. T. Parsons is having the roof of his shop raised and the place otherwise repaired. When completed the building will be an ornament to the town.

A great smoke was seen rising over the southside hill yesterday, and at first it was thought Island Cove was on fire. It turned out later that it was only a fire of brushwood, &c., and no damage was done.

It is pleasing to be able to report that the finalizing of the dock arrangements has been completed. The company, known as the Marine Railway and Dock Co., Ltd., has been given their charter and are now all but ready to put their stock on the market. Through the kindness of Mr. F. J. Fitzgerald, Secretary and Manager for the company, we were shown the prospectus and other documents in connection with this commendable piece of work, commendable not only for the benefit a marine dock will be to the schooner owners but to the town generally, for in our opinion every schooner, whether small or large, entering the port is a benefit in the way of money spent and em-

ployment given. Mr. Fitzgerald is very much interested in his work and enthusiastic over its success. The capital stock will be \$50,000 in five thousand \$10 shares. It is the desire of the company to reach schooner owners as much as possible. The Government has given the site free, and guarantees stock-holders 5 per cent for ten years. All material and equipment that cannot be made in the country will be admitted free of duty. The dock will consist of two railways of a capacity of 500 and 300 tons respectively. These railways will be so arranged that the outside vessel can be put off without interfering with the work on the other. Four schooners can be placed on the dock at one time. The great drawback to schooner owners docking their vessels in St. John's is delay, and the Harbor Grace dock will do away with this delay. With the improved plant and machinery a schooner can be taken up in less than half an hour. The building of the dock must be a great benefit to Harbor Grace, and we trust that all our people will help to make it so. The gentlemen composing the company are sure of success, so sure in fact that a large amount of the stock has been purchased by themselves. This in our opinion is good as it shows the faith they have in the undertaking.

The Archer Novelty and Comedy Company now playing here are making a fine impression with their great variety of amusements. The company are thorough ladies and gentlemen and sustained the reputation they gained when in St. John's. ## Rosalind in Port.

The s.s. Rosalind, Capt. Smith, arrived here at 2.30 p.m. Saturday from New York and Halifax. She left the former port Sunday week at noon and arrived at Halifax Wednesday morning, leaving for here Thursday morning. Since leaving New York she has had nothing but rain and fog right through. She ship brought a full cargo. While in New York she got a new tall shaft and her funnel was painted with the Black Diamond Line colors.
