## Household Notes.

When glass is broken, a very good way to pick it up is to wet a woollen cloth, lay it on the floor where the fragments will adhere to the damp cloth, which you can burn.

Stains caused by heated dishes on trays or tables, can be removed by a thin paste made of salad oil and salt. Spread it over the marked place and leave it for an hour or more; then rub it off with a soft cloth.

Cheese can be prevented from molding by wringing a cloth out of vinegar and wrap it around the cheese, and the whole put in a large paper bag.
