

TO-DAY'S MESSAGES.

HON. T. A. CRERAR ON THE STAND

OTTAWA, May 5. The examination and cross-examination of Hon. T. A. Crerar, who was a director of the Home Bank from 1910, to 1918, occupied the complete to-day, When an adjournment was reached shortly before five o'clock, Mr. Crerar was still on the stand. He will be further examined to-morrow. The whole trend of Mr. Crerar's evice was to the effect that the wesern directors of the Bank became turbed in regard to the condition of the Bank as far back as 1915. They protested against certain accounts eing particularly anxious about the advance to the Prudential Trust ieral Manager of the Home Bank at that time. They felt the Bank would not succeed under his management. Their uneasiness culminated in a letter written to Sir Thomas White, the Minister of Finance, asking for an independent audit of the Bank.

CANADA'S UNPAID INCOME TAX. OTTAWA, May 5.

The total amount of income, tax overdue and unpaid from the inception of the Act in 1917 to March 31 last was little under two million dollars, according to information given to J. S. Woodsworth, Labor centre, Winnipeg, by Minister of Finance, Hon. J. Robb, in the House of Comnons this afternoon. The total assessments for income tax during the period was \$267,004,599, while collections exclusive of penalties and interest amounted to \$265,228,674.

FRENCH COLONIAL SYSTEM EF-FECTIVE.

LONDON, May 5. France is building an African empire far surpassing the ancient domains of Rome and Carthage, according to Davis P. Barrows, a former President of the University of California, who is returning to the United States after a study of French Colonial administration, which, he said, compares most favorably with the colonial achievements of any country. He said he was agreeably surprised to find the French Colonial administration was not as militariatic as had been generally reported, and that in his opinion the natives were being educated and civilized without being brutalized.

COALITION TO BE ORGANIZED IN GERMANY.

BERLIN, May 5. Unless official recount of ballots deprives the United Socialists of the present rank as numerically the strongest party in the new Reichstag, President Ebert will in the course of the next few days commission the leaders to proceed with the work of organizing the new Coalition Government. In that event the Socialists will either promptly reject the assignment or summon the leaders of the cler-Democratic parties for the purpose of discussing the formation of a big-Coalition, which on the basis of present returns would definitely control a total of 229 mandates out of 448. Only 189 of the opposition votes contributed by the Nationalists, Communists, and Ludendorff party can be classified as a fixed Opposition factor. The remaining 39 votes are distributed among the Bavarian People's Party and hold a dozen minor political
