And whereas a copy of this by-law hath been duly rublished according to law. AND HE IT ENACTED that, the proceeds of the said debentures shall be applied and apportioned to the several purposes hereinbefore menioned, and in the amounts and proportion aforesaid, the grants of the said local municipalities to be paid to the Treasurers thereof respectively, to be applied by them strictly to the purposes aforesaid, and an account of such application to be returned by each Reeve to the Council of the said County, at the next December Session of this Council.

No person lending money upon or purchasing said Debenjures shall be bound to see to the application of the proceeds thereof.

AND BE IT ENACTED that, this By law shall take effect upon, from and after the first day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.
