

**NORTH MIDDLESEX
NOMINATION DAY**

Messrs. Mitchell and Doyle Were
Named by Large Gather-
ing at Ailsa Craig.

LOOKS LIKE CLOSE RACE

Much Resentment Throughout Riding
Over the Gerrymandering by the
Whitney Government.

Ailsa Craig, Nov. 29.—A very large
throng of electors gathered today at
the nomination meeting to elect a suc-
cessor to Mr. Duncan C. Ose, who re-
tired to contest West Middlesex in the
Dominion House.

Every section of the riding was re-
presented, and the town hall was crowd-
ed to capacity when the nominations
were being made.

Only two names were placed in nom-
ination—Mr. James W. Doyle, of Bid-
duldulph, farmer, Conservative, and
Mr. John Mitchell, of Parkhill, grain mer-
chant, Liberal.

Hon. A. G. Mackay, Liberal leader,
spoke on behalf of Mr. Mitchell, and
Hon. W. J. Hanna, provincial secre-
tary, addressed the electors on behalf
of Mr. Doyle.

The campaign has been a very quiet
one so far, but both men have done ef-
fective canvassing work. From all in-
dications the fight will be close, with
the odds in favor of the Liberal candi-
date. The gerrymandering is a source of
complaint among the Conservatives,
and a large number will show their re-
sultant at the polls. Party Organ-
izers Inwood and Carstairs were pres-
ent.

**EXPLORER COOK
HAS DISAPPEARED**

Relatives Declare That He Has
Not Sailed For Europe.

IS NOW ILL IN NEW YORK

Walter Wellmann Charges Him With
Faking in Claim of Having
Reached Pole.

New York, Nov. 28.—A combing of
Manhattan today to find further infor-
mation about the movements of Dr.
Frederick A. Cook, the Arctic explorer,
who disappeared yesterday, and if
possible something definite as to
whether or not he had secretly left
America, brought no results. But over
in Bedford avenue, Brooklyn, Wm. L.
Cook, the explorer's brother, told
everything worth while about his dis-
tinguished brother except the exact
street number.

"Dr. Cook is right here in New York
City," said Wm. L. Cook, "and I could
talk with him today and I could call
him up and get him on the telephone
at this minute if I wanted to do so;
but I don't want to disturb him again
today."

It was suggested that the doctor's
health had become impaired, and a
statement he made to a friend to the
effect that "if this thing keeps up a
few months longer I will be in the
insane asylum," tended to strengthen
this theory.

On Verge of Collapse.
Although some of his friends main-
tain that he has been badly under the
strain of lecturing and preparing his
data, an intimate associate said to-
night that the explorer appeared to be
on the verge of nervous breakdown.
Those who had taken sides against
him in his claims contend that it
proves their contention that he was
mistaken in saying he reached the
pole on April 21, 1908.

While the doctor's brother talked to-
night at his home of his brother's
"persecution by conspirators," his tele-
phone was ringing steadily, but Mr.
Cook let it ring until it got tired, and
paid no attention to it.

These conspirators, according to Mr.
Cook, first drove the doctor to the Ho-
tel Grammat at Bronxville and later
into deeper seclusion.

"But H. Wellington, 'Went' it was
suggested to Mr. Cook, 'sent out a
statement today that the doctor had
sailed to Europe on the Caronia.'"
"He is my brother's lawyer, isn't he?"
asked Mr. Cook. "Well, I don't
know anything for sure, but he thinks
Dr. Cook went to Europe,
he's wrong."

Calls Cook Fakir.
Washington, Nov. 28.—Walter Well-
mann, whose preparation for a conquest
of the North Pole in an airship re-
cently were abandoned, issues tonight
a statement in which he analyzed the
narrative of the two claimants of
polar discovery, declaring that of
Peary, "precise, workmanlike, consistent,
credible in every particular," and
denouncing that of Dr. Cook as "self
evident and even deliberate impos-
ture."

The gist of Mr. Wellmann's findings
is that with his meagre party and
equipment Dr. Cook could not possibly
have accomplished the feat for which
he claims credit, that his astronomical
data are too minutely precise to
have been made under the claimed
conditions in the field, and that the
explorer's daring for lecture plat-
form and his acceptance of "crowns of
flowers placed upon his head by in-
nocent women and children" before sub-
mitting his field records to scientific
examination, all conspire to discredit
him.

"That which he claims to have done,"
declared Mr. Wellmann, referring to
Cook, "with his equipment and orga-
nization, was physically impossible."
"Mr. Cook's narrative is to the
trained eye and ear a story of counter-
feit presentment."

BIRTLE VOTES LIBERAL.
Winnipeg, Nov. 28.—Mr. Malcolm

**IMPORTANT MEETING

ing the King street school, which, of
course, necessitate the rearrange-
ment of the school boundaries.

considered.

**SPECIAL SESSION
OF CITY COUNCIL**

City Daddies Will Make Another
Attempt to Settle Street
Lighting Matter.

THAT GARBAGE BYLAW

May Be Rejected in View of the City
Solicitor's Opinion in Regard to
the Debentures.

There will be a meeting of the coun-
cil this evening to consider the London
Electric contract and the garbage
system bylaw.

The communication from the London
Electric company refusing to accept
the terms offered by the city will be
read, and then there will be a debate.
It is not considered likely that a set-
tlement will be arrived at today.

It will be remembered that last year
the same question came up, and that
six months before a solution was
arrived at.

The company will insist upon a sim-
ple contract, which the council will
not sign what the company want.

Will Light the City.
The company will continue to light
the city streets, and the argument will
be used as to whether or not the
payment of any money to the
company will involve the city.

A compromise may be arrived at,
but it is very hard to see where it
will come in.

As for the garbage system bylaw it
is probable that it will be rejected.
To issue debentures for ten years to
cover the cost of the system will make
it somewhat expensive to maintain,
say some of the aldermen, and they
will reject it until such a time as the
economical spirit is not abroad in the
council.

**NEWEST DREADNOUGHT
GIGANTIC AND FAST**

A Battleship Lion Will Carry
Huge Battery and Sail 27
Knots an Hour.

London, Nov. 28.—The keel plates of
two new warships, the Orion, the im-
proved Dreadnought battleship, and
the Lion, the cruiser battleship, were
laid today at Portsmouth and Devon-
port. The bulk of the material for both
vessels is ready and all arrangements
have been made for their completion
within two years.

The construction of the Lion will
mark a notable step in the evolution
of the cruising battleship. She will
have 70,000 horsepower, while her im-
mediate predecessor had 45,000. She
will displace 21,000 tons, and her
length will be 700 feet, constituting
her the longest man-of-war ever laid
down. What is technically known as
"her" run of deck indicates an inten-
tion to equip the cruiser battleship
with ten 12-inch guns, thus placing her
as regards armament on an equality
with the latest battleships. She will
have a nominal speed of 27
knots an hour.
