The fire originated in the roof of the boiler house and was confined to that part of the building.

Next year, the convention of the Business Educators' Association of Canada will be held at the Berlin Business College, this city. This was decided at the annual convention held in St. Catharines last Friday. Mr. W. D. Euler, of Berlin was elected Vice President.

Lineman May Survive 2,200 Volts Through Body.

With hundreds of people looking on, a lineman was struck by a 2,200 volt electric pole, suffering from a severe burn. The man, who was working on a line near the city hall, was thrown into the air and fell. He was taken to the hospital, but his condition is serious.

Well-Behaved Soldiers.

A revelation as to the splendid conduct and behaviour of the overseas soldiers in London camp is said to be the report submitted by Major Osborne, provost-marshal, for the past month. Several battalions have been fortunate in such exemplary conduct on the part of their men, that only one to two cases of drunkenness are registered against a whole battalion. Other battalions show a total number of "crimes" which would fall far below this number of offenses committed within a period by a civilian community of the same number of men.

Clerk's Grievous Error.

An error made by a new and inexperienced clerk in the record office of the Militia Department Ottawa has temporarily raised false hopes among some sixty families throughout Canada. After they had been notified that relatives had been killed or wounded in action, a subsequent notification, affecting the same names exactly, was sent out that the men had sailed from Liverpool to Quebec. Explanations of the error and apologies have been sent out.

Returns Show Decrease.

The customs returns for the port of Galt for the month of June, show a decrease of \$774.59, in comparison with the returns for same period of 1915 the figures are: June, 1916, \$43,526.82; June, 1915, \$44,301.41; decrease, \$774.59.

Clemency Not Likely.

The capital case of Toney Legato under sentence of death at Guelph, Ont., for the murder of a fellow-countryman, is under advisement by the Cabinet Council. It is understood that the decision is to allow the law to take its course and not interfere with the sentence of the court, says an Ottawa despatch.

A Runaway Auto.

A motor car left standing in front of the Bank of Montreal Guelph took a notion to go for a little jaunt on its own hook, and started off across the square. It was stopped opposite the fountain by the Wellington bus driver.

Stabbed in the Face.

With one of his cars stabbed and a wound in the face, William Martin, 30 York street Hamilton was found in the Market square in a semi-conscious condition and taken to the City Hospital, where his wounds were dressed. Martin, who is 20 years of age, and conducts a boot store on the market, was unable to give any information as to what had occurred.

Italian Returned to U.S.

Charged with forcing his way into Canada by evading the immigration officials, Henry Petina an Italian, who was arrested on Thursday by Detectives Shirley and Smith Hamilton was taken back to Bridgeburg yesterday by Immigration Inspector Sharp.

Fined for Hitting Soldier.

M. Poulios at the Bradford Police Court was fined \$20 and costs for hitting a returned soldier in a cafe. Though the evidence showed that he had been called a name by John MacDonald, and hit first, the magistrate held that Poulios, who is in charge of the cafe, should have called the police before the blow was struck.

Doc's Horses Scarce.

A great scarcity of heavy horses is now being felt in Sarnia. Contractors are having difficulty in getting the necessary animals to carry their loads. One contractor, who has a number of jobs on the go, wants six extra teams, and he could not secure one of them. A large number of heavy draft horses from Lambton County have been shipped to Michigan during the past few months and with the drain caused by the big war, the horse population of the county has received a shock.

Die on Same Day.

Dr. James Franklin Mather and his brother, Adam Mather, died—the former, in California, whither he had gone for his health, and the latter, in Belleville—both on Friday evening last. Dr. Mather was a graduate of Queen's University and practiced in Belleville. Their deaths were only a few hours apart.

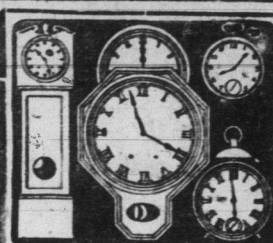
