lands which may be required for railway or general public purposes.

••

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT.

Any man 18 years of age, any head of a family, on a widow (British subjects) may record 160 acres, the fee being \$2. The settler must enter into occupation within thirty days after recording, and must continue to occupy it. Absence for a longer period than two months consecutively is deemed cessation of occupation. Leave of absence may be granted not exceeding four months in any one year. After, providing that he has made improvements to the value of \$2.50 cents per acre, a Crown Grant is issued, costing \$5.

Settlers may employ agents. Indians or Chinese cannot be agents.
