During the past few years, the number of floating logs in the northern rivers has increased significantly. This is due to the fact that the logging industry has expanded into the northern regions of the country. The floating logs are a serious problem for the environment and for the navigation of the rivers. It is necessary to take measures to reduce the number of floating logs and to prevent the damage they cause to the rivers and to the environment.

It was evident that there was a lack of will to change the existing situation. The logging industry was needed when a million cubic meters of timber floated downstream, but today only one-third of that volume is being transported. It is the only reason not to close them, they are needed for the minimum number of logs floating on the river. It is a simple fact that as the way it has always been done, a plan to clear the river of floating logs need not be formulated by experts who receive their salaries to change things, not just blindly continue doing what has been done in the past. It is necessary to make a change in the way of thinking in the northern Arkhangelsk.
