export interest is stimulated. Perhaps, a central trading
company or agency should be established in Canada whose sole
purpose would be to 1) buy cores in the world market,
2) transport them to Canada, 3) announce the availability,
buying and selling price to the rebuilding community,
4) return rebuilt product to the country of origin and
5) assume profit on final selling transaction. The establishment
of such an agency abroad whose function would be to buy and ship
acceptable cores and then act as sales agent for the returned
Canadian rebuilt products.

Clearly, however, a precondition for such action would be the establishment of an industry association to act as a focal point in addressing the domestic concerns and export opportunities of the industry.
