AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SULTANATE OF OMAN FOR THE TRAINING IN CANADA OF PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE SULTANATE OF OMAN

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Sultanate of Oman hereinafter referred to as Canada and Oman respectively,

CONSIDERING that Oman has requested Canada to provide training in Canada for personnel of the armed forces of Oman.

HAVE AGREED as follows:

# ARTICLE 1

### **Definitions**

In this Agreement

- (a) "trainee" means a member of the armed forces of Oman who has been authorised by his government to undergo training in Canada with the Canadian Forces and who has been accepted by Canada for training.
- (b) "training" means the military training prescribed by the Chief of the Defence Staff of the Canadian Forces.

#### ARTICLE 2

## Training and Costs

Subject to terms and conditions of this Agreement, Canada shall provide training in Canada for trainees in such numbers as may from time to time be agreed upon by the appropriate authorities of Oman and Canada.

### ARTICLE 3

Unless other arrangements are made for particular courses of training, costs shall be borne as follows:

- (a) Canada shall bear the cost of:
  - (i) the allowances mentioned in subparagraphs (b)(i) and (ii) of Article 4,
