

## ARTICLE XIV (Cont'd)

Contracting Party and points on the agreed services in third countries, the designated airline or airlines of one Contracting Party shall have the right to introduce matching tariffs at prices not lower or with conditions less restrictive than the tariffs applied by the third and fourth freedom airline or airlines on the same sectors. In all cases of matching, tariffs filings shall include satisfactory evidence of the availability of the tariffs which are being matched and of the consistency of matching with the requirement of this Article. Unless otherwise agreed between the aeronautical authorities of the two Contracting Parties, tariffs which are introduced for matching purposes shall remain in effect only for the period of availability of the tariff or charter retail price being matched.

9. The aeronautical authorities of both Contracting Parties shall endeavour to ensure that (1) the tariffs charged and collected conform to the tariffs approved by both aeronautical authorities and (2) no airline rebates any portion of such tariffs by any means, directly or indirectly, including the payment of excessive sales commissions to agents.

## ARTICLE XV

## (Sales and Transfer of Funds)
