

- (ii) to have access to airport customs processing and facilities for cargo moving by surface or by air; and
 - (iii) to elect to perform their own surface transportation or to provide it through arrangements with surface carriers, subject to regulatory requirements, including surface transportation operated by other airlines.
- (b) Such intermodal cargo services may be offered at a single, through price for the air and surface transportation combined, provided that shippers are fully informed of the identity of the operator and the mode of transportation for each segment of the transportation.
