MULLARD SPACE SCIENCE LABORATORY

The Mullard Space Science Laboratory is part of the Department of Physics and Astronomy of University College, London, UK.

The laboratory has been extremely successful in winning competitions and contracts for placing payloads on space vehicles and has taken advantage of launch opportunities offered by NASA, ESA, and German Space Agency, Japan and the Soviet Union. The Laboratory has programs of research directed towards Earth conversation, space plasmaphysics, solar physics and X-Ray as it has acquired a great deal of expertise in detector systems, computing, and the electronic and mechanical engineering associated with space payloads.

The subcommittee will hold further meetings in Vienna and Geneva in March and will be reporting to the Spring Session of the North Atlantic Assembly being held this year in Banff, Alberta, Canada in May 1992.
