We have had numerous inquiries from ex-soldiers trying to get free passage to England - many of the boys seem not to be satisfied in either England or Canada. In view of the above I would refer to the Rev. Mr. Chisholm who is one of the most active members of the British Immigration Aid Association of which your esteemed Principal is Vice-President.
