Dear Professor Best:-

With reference to your letter of April 28th and the circular published by the Department of Religious Education of Montreal Theological Colleges I wish to say that I am very much interested in the formation of the Department of Education in connection with this University.

I believe such a Department would have all the advantages to which you make reference in your letter and I believe it would serve a useful purpose. Before it could be established it would have to be endorsed by the Faculties and Departments concerned and approved by Corporation.
