

ARTICLE I.

NAME.—This organization shall be known as the Canadian Electrical Association.

ARTICLE II.

OBJECT.—The object of this Association shall be to advance the science of electricity and to promote the interests of those engaged in any electrical enterprise and for discussion and interchange of opinions among its members.

ARTICLE III.

MEMBERSHIP.—The Association shall consist of active, associate and honorary members. The term Active Members includes all members actually engaged in electrical business. The term Associate includes those interested or actively engaged in any electrical pursuit, and they shall be entitled to attend all meetings of the Association, except those of the Executive, and take part in all discussions, but shall not be entitled to vote or be eligible for office. Honorary members shall be elected by a two-thirds vote of the Active members present.

ARTICLE IV.

OFFICERS.—The officers shall consist of a President, 1st and 2nd Vice-Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer, and an Executive Committee, consisting of ten members, five of whom shall act on the Committee for two consecutive years. The President and Vice-Presidents shall be ex-officio members of the Committee. Five shall form a quorum. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by one person.

ARTICLE V.

FEES.—The annual fee shall be for active members \$3.00, associate members \$2.00, payable in advance.

ARTICLE VI.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS.—All officers shall be elected by ballot at a general meeting of the Association. The ballot shall be taken in the following manner :—The Secretary shall read the list
