them. But this is a matter which can be regulated by the rules and regulations of the prison inspectors or by an order from the Provincial Attorney General to the Sheriffs, and I believe that it will be sufficient to draw their attention to it.

If you should require any instructions on any legal questions which may arise during your proceedings, you may apply in open court to the presiding judge, and the information which you require will be given to you.
