His Royal Highness Prince Edward was on shore from the beginning of the embarkation to the very laft, and was in the utmost danger; he shewed great bravery, notwithstanding the enemy's shot shew about him on every side, and greatly encuraged the failors, begging of them to do their duty; he could hardly be perfuaded to get into the boat (which was waiting for him, being defirous to see the issue) although the Commodore often follicited him to go on board, frequently reminding him of the danger he was in, and the failors who were diligent in their duty in re-embarking of the troops, he rewarded. His prefence on this occasion, I make no doubt, faved many of the mens' lives.
