

for his decision, but shall have no other privileges in debate thereon.

26. No member can be given permission to retire when only a quorum is present.

27. This Lodge shall be governed in debate and on questions of order by "Roberts' Manual" in so far as it is consistent with the laws and work of the Order, or when none of these rules of order apply to the case in point.

28. Any of these rules of order may be suspended for the time being by a two-thirds vote of the members present.

29. These rules of order may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided the proposed amendment has been submitted in writing to the Lodge at some previous annual session.
