Is not man but as an atom in thy univerfe; and the fon of man but as a worm before thee? Or if our own infignificance be infufficient to fhield us from thy wrath, hear, we befeech thee, the voice of interceffion from Him whomthou heareft always; and look on the blood that flowed from the crofs to wafhaway the fins of men and of nations.

ABSTINENCE from food is nothing ; nor are any outward marks of humiliation of the least importance, but fo far as they are undiffembled and faithful. tokens of the affections which prevail within. We have, this day, affembled to make confession of our fins, and to implore, for ourfelves and for our country, the pardon of heaven, and the continuance of that protection and favour, by which, above every other land, ours has been long and eminently diffinguished. To the prayer of unleigned piety the God, whom we ferve, refuseth not to liken. But let us beware of deceiving ourfelves:
