His extreme Right reached the Observatory knoll. The 48th stood in reserve near the top of Maple Avenue. In 1787 H. M. KING WILLIAM IV attended a review on the BATTLEFIELD. The present so-called "Plains of Abraham" have been the scene of ROYAL REVIEWS before T. R. H. the PRINCESS LOUISE and the DUKE OF ALBANY, in 1880, and the PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES in 1901.
