Article II. section 1. will now read: The association shall be composed of lacrosse clubs, which shall agree to abide by and comply with the rules of the association, and to adopt the following definition:

"An amateur is one who has never engaged in assisted in, or taught any athletic exercise, as a means of pecuniary gain, and who has never taken part in any competition with anyone who is not an amateur.

"Exception: That amateur athletes shall not lose their amateur status, by competing with or against professionals, in lacrosse matches, for which no money prizes are given, or in championship competitions, permitted by any lacrosse association.


