ESTIMATE FOR THE BOARD OF HEALTH

Decision was made yesterday by the finance committee of the municipal council that it would not recommend that assessment be made for health purposes this year. The matter will come up when the council meets next week. Sessions were held yesterday in the morning, afternoon and evening, with Mayor Schofield presiding.

Morning, afternoon and evening sessions were held by the committee, which met in the office of the county secretary, when estimates for 1922 of various situations were considered. Mayor Schofield, chairman of the committee, presided, and others present were: Warden Bullock, Councillors Jones, Thornton, Prink, O'Brien, Campbell, Golding, Anderson and Donovan, and the secretary, J. King Kelley.

The first business taken up was consideration of the statement of the Municipal Home. The committee completed consideration of this statement and it was laid on the table.

Judge Armstrong was heard on behalf of Samuel Mulaney, of Musquash, who claimed a refund of money furnished for criminal prosecution. The matter was referred to the county secretary and Councillor Thornton.

County Hospital.

The commissioners of the St. John County Hospital requested the sum of \$2,000, in addition to their regular estimates, for the purpose of establishing a new ward for children. This matter was discussed at length and the County Hospital commissioners were directed to proceed with the establishment of the ward if they could take the cost out of the estimates for 1922. If not, they were to report back and state the definite amount required for the alterations.

The estimates of the board of health were next considered. At the morning session this application was laid over until next week.

NEW YORK-LONDON SERVICE ON 24-HOUR SCHEDULE

Washington, Jan. 12 - New York-London air service on a twenty-four hour schedule is foreseen by the aviation experts of the United States, Great Britain, France, Italy and Japan, who drafted the report on aircraft limitation, for submission to the armament conference. The report says:

"A reliable air service from Europe to America in, say, twenty-four hours, should prove a richly profitable undertaking."

The experts also forecast travel by air at altitudes far beyond anything heretofore accomplished. The report goes on:

"The success of recent experiments indicates that, with special means of super charging motors, navigation of the air will in the future utilize high regions of the atmosphere to take advantage of a less resistance of the air and by favorable high velocity of winds."

Privately, one of the experts predicted that in the not far distant future he expected to see the air lanes at ten to twenty miles up. The advantage of this, he said, would be to take advantage of winds, which would double or treble the present speed of aeroplanes.

"It is not easy to foresee what consequences to human progress will come in the future from the development of aeroplanes in all its branches," the experts say, in their formal report. "They will certainly be marvellous where national conditions are favorable in such development."

CABBAGES AND SNAKES.

Cabbages and snakes are the chief features of New Year Island, a tiny speck of 160 acres in the Bass Strait, between Australia and Tasmania. The island was formerly uninhabited, but about seventy years ago a visitor from a passing vessel planted a field of cabbages there. These have grown to such an extent that the biggest are twelve feet high. Two Australian soldiers settled on New Year Island last winter, and in four months killed 1,070 snakes; but in spite of their efforts, the island still swarms with them.
