I.—SUMMARY OF SCHOOLS, SCHOOL DAYS, TEACHERS, AND ATTENDANCE AND COST OF PUPILS, FOR THE YEAR 1861.

The following summary shows the number of Schools, of days during which the Schools were open, of Teachers, and of Pupils in attendance; together with the entire cost of the Schools for the year, and the cost per pupil.

1. NUMBER OF SCHOOLS.

The number of Schools was eight, (8,) namely, the Palace Street, George Street, Park, Victoria Street, Louisa Street, John Street, Phoebe Street and Givins Street Schools; each of which has a separate Male and Female Department.

2. NUMBER OF SCHOOL DAYS.
