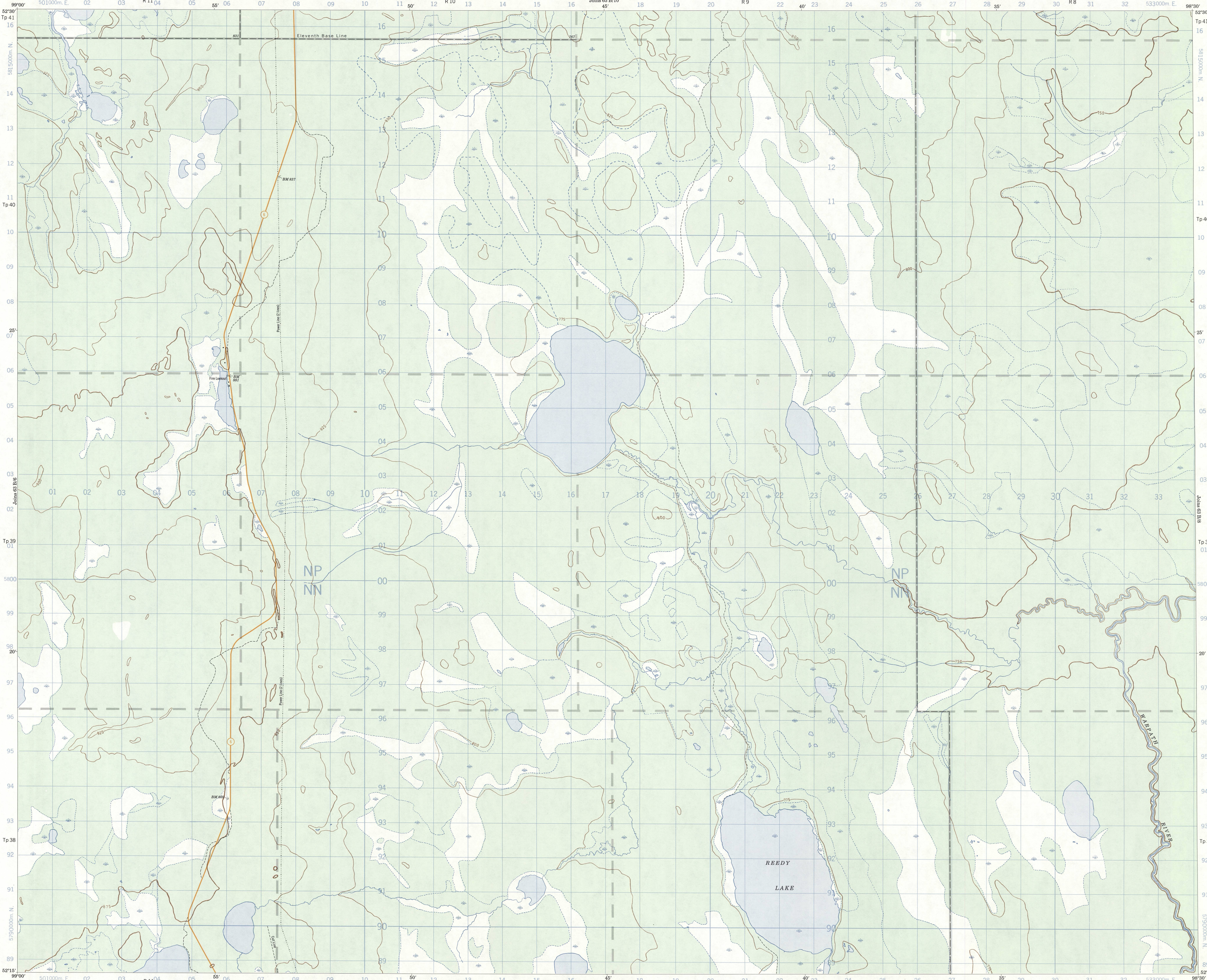

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING CASE REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THE MAP
REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Road number on grid line
immediately to left of point
Estimate distance of square from
this line eastward to point
NORTHING: Road number on grid line
immediately below point
Estimate distance of square from
this line northward to point
EXAMPLE: MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975984
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
