London, Feb. 1. The Times' Madrid correspondent telegraphs that it is persuaded by private information that a great effort is being made to secure an armistice with the Carlists as a preliminary to definite peace.

Many reports are in circulation with regard to the future Liberal leadership. It is stated that Mr. Forster is personally not desirous of taking the post, and that two members of the late Government have informed Lord Granville that some Whigs and Ultra Nonconformists will succeed from the party if Forster is chosen.

Spain's Civil War. The Alphonse has taken Mount Laga, and the relief of Pamplona is considered certain. The Carlists are abandoning the route without resistance.

Great Britain has declined to send a representative to St. Petersburg to the International Conference.
