And now Brethren; I have given a full account of my labors during the year, and am sorry that I cannot report having visited all the Lodges. I would recommend to my successor that he first visit those Lodges I do not report upon.

The time occupied in my visitations was considerable, and though it may appear small work to the brethren generally, perhaps they will be surprised when I inform them that I travelled in all 647 miles.
