Hon. James Richardson (Minister of Supply and Services): In so far as Polymer Corporation Limited is concerned: 1. (a) One; (b) Eight; (c) None. One member of the Executive is bilingual.

- 2. (a) One; (b) Eight; (c) None. Two Board members are bilingual.
- 3. The capital expenditures in Ontario as represented by fixed assets, amounted to \$163,593,000 as of December 31, 1968. The Company does not have any fixed assets in Quebec and does not have a record of the value of the capital assets it has purchased in Quebec.
- 4. No. The capacity of the Company's existing Canadian operations is sufficient for its current needs and the Company, therefore, does not have any current plans to establish a subsidiary or branch elsewhere in Canada.
