A Screwless Corkscrew. The ordinary form of corkscrew, while effective enough for its purpose, often destroys or renders useless the cork on which it is used, frequently breaking it and causing particles of cork to be mixed with the liquid in the bottle. A new device recently patent ed in England, avoids these disadvant.




