LONDON, March 16.—The Times, in its financial article yesterday, says: "As the army, navy and civil estimates only show an aggregate reduction of £100,000, there will be no large surplus, but possibly a small deficit shown in the forthcoming budget. Unless the remaining 27 days of the financial year show an unexpected elasticity in the revenue there will be no basis for estimating the revenue of the coming year at more than £84,850,000 against an estimated expenditure of £85,300,000."
