BELL, ADAM CARR. (*Pictou*.)

S. of Basil Bell, Esq., who came from Haddingtonshire, Scot., and Mary dau. of Adam Carr, Esq., a native of Northumberland, Eng., one of the first lessees of the Albion mines, Pictou. B. in Pictou, N.S., 11 Nov. 1847. Ed. in New Glasgow, N.S., Sackville, N.B., and Glasgow Univ. M., at New Glasgow, 4 Sept. 1873, Miss Annie Henderson. Was Warden of New Glasgow in 1876, and again in 1884. Sworn a mem. of the Ex. Council and Provl. Secretary. 25 May, 1882; resigned with his colleagues 18 July, 1882. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g.e. 1878, and re-elected at last g.e. Is Leader of the Opposition. A Liberal Conservative.—*New Glasgow, N.S.*

BLAIR, WILLIAM M., J.P. (*Colchester*.)

Family originally from Blair Athol, Scot. B. in Onslow 25 May, 1836. Ed. there. M., 26 Jan. 1864, Harriet, dau. of Sam. James Blair. A farmer. Is a J.P., and Lieut. Col. commanding 78th Batt. Highlanders, Colchester, Hants and Pictou Militia. Chairman of the Agricultural Exhibition Committee, and Presdt. of the Onslow Agricultural Soc. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g.e. 1878, and re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Onslow, Co. Colchester, N.S.*
