An Act to declare the meaning of the Auction Duties Act of 1841, with respect to sales in rural districts.

THEREAS doubts have arisen as to the correct interpretation of the Preamble. Auction Duties Act of 1841, and it is desirable to remove the same : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., declares and enacts as follows :

I. The provisions of the Act of 1841, intituled, An Act to make certain Act 4.5 Y. 5 alterations in the law relative to the duty upon sales of property by auction, c. 21, declared were never intended by the Legislature to apply, and do not apply to the to certain sales by auction frequently held in the rural districts, but not for trading sales. purposes, either by the inhabitants selling their furniture, grain, cattle, and other property, when changing their residence, or for any other necessary 10 cause,, or by merchants leaving off business.
