"No Means No" Date Rape Awareness Week

Facts: In the 1991 UNB Counselling Services' Un-
wanted Sexual Experience Survey Report", it was
found that in a one-year period:

- 1/4 of students will be the victim of an unwanted sexual experience
- 17% of women will be raped
- 7% of men will be raped
- 93% of victims will know their aggressor (boyfriend/girlfriend, non-romantic friend, date, family member, etc)
- less than 1/2 of victims told someone about the assault
- 7% of victims report the incident to a person in authority (proctor/don, counsellor, security, police)
