The Brunswickan would like to clarify the policy on submitting classifieds for
publication.

1. To begin
Classifieds are a free service offered by The Brunswickan to the staff and stu-
dents of UNB and STU.
 2. Submission
Classifieds must be received by 5pm on Tuesday of the week of publication.
There are two methods. (a) e-mail from a UNB or STU account. (b) personal
delivery to Rm 35 in the SUB. Personal deliveries MUST be accompanied by a
valid UNB/STU id card.
 3. Re-Submission
If you wish a classified to run for more than 1 week, you must submit it each
week.
 4. Content
Classifieds should be 30 words or less. Your name, phone# and id# should be
appended to the ad.
 5. Disclosure
Classifieds are not confidential. The editorial board will provide names of
submitters if they feel that the circumstances warrant it.
 6. Inclusion
Acceptance of a classified does not guarantee publication. The number of clas-
sified printed may be limited by available space.
 7. And finally
The Brunswickan reserves the right to refuse to publish any classified deemed
to be offensive. If you have any complaints they should be addressed to the
