Memorandum, Dr.Scott:

Agent Frank Edwards of Kenora, reports that C.W.Cox, the timber licensee in the northern portion of the Lac Seul is conducting a wasteful operation and leaving a serious fire hazard due to the manufacture of hewn ties in the bush. The agent recommends that a timber cruiser be employed to visit the reserve and make an inspection.

I would recommend that he be given Mauthority to secure a reliable man to do this work.
