
Ottawa, April 7, 1909.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of communication from yourself and other Indians, of the 18th ultimo, in connection with disposition of land in the western portion of Nova Scotia, and in reply to say that no sale of timber on Indian lands in this province has recently been made.

A lease has been issued of the Fairy Lake Indian Reserve, to be used for pleasure purposes, the lessee paying a fair rental therefor and a provision being included in lease that there is to be no sale of the timber on the reserve.
