



Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 13th Instant regarding the property occupied by the Church of England at Kettle Point, being the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 1, Range B, I beg to say that in view of resolution by the Indians of the 12th Instant, you should notify Adam Shawanoe that his right to this Lot has been cancelled and that he should deliver up the key of the Church to you at once, and notify him that he will not be allowed to interfere in any way with the use of the Lot for Church purposes.
