Rev. Sir,-

I beg to advise you that the Department has approved of the appointment of Mr. George F. Richardson, who has been teaching the Tuft's Cove Indian School, as teacher of the Whyoccomagh School. He has been informed that he may commence his duties there as soon as Mr. Gillis leaves and he will be paid at the same rate as at Tuft's Cove, viz- \$400.00 per annum.

Mr. Gillis should forward a return in the usual way for the number of days he taught during this quarter and when this is received a cheque for the amount due him will be forwarded.
