Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant and to say that you may inform the Trout Creek Lumber Company, Powassan, Ont., that permission is hereby given to haul loads of lumber across the Dokis Indian reserve similarly to last year and on the payment of 25¢ per thousand feet of lumber which you should collect in due time. It is understood that the Indians will not be ~~necessarily~~ called upon to keep the road in repair and that no damage will be done by cutting timber etc., in the reserve.
