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- (3) The Bracken party is not yet truly active.
- (4) The C.C.F. is highly dangerous in urban ridings because it is deliberately cultivating the middle class now that its worker programme is rolling.
- (5) Among Protestants, there are signs that the C.C.F. is deliberately wheedling Nonconformist churches, as it has done in Ontario.
- (6) Le Bloc is using race, religion and family, not to say provincial autonomy.
- (7) L'Union des Electeurs, a Social Credit organization, is active in Eastern Quebec.
- (8) The Liberals are, among many people, considered hopelessly beaten and nothing is more dangerous in political Quebec.
- (9) Yet the Liberals, federal and provincial, have not yet begun to fight; the rivals have fired their ammunition, set forth their programmes. That is the sole bright spot for the Liberals.

Platform for Quebec

The Government's war record, it is suggested, is now more of a liability than an asset for three reasons:

- (1) Among the French it brings up conscription, plebiscite, etc.
- (2) Among French and English the attitude is that we have paid plenty for whatever showing the Government has made.
- (3) War is looking back; eyes are now turned to the post-war period.

In connection with the post-war period, the people are tired of vagaries about the brave new world. The farmer is afraid his prices will drop, the workman is afraid he will be back on the dole; the white collar man is afraid the boss will exploit him and cut his salary; the manufacturer is afraid of tariff reductions; bankers are afraid of nationalization and so on.

The Liberals have done nothing to answer a million questions.
