A shore traverse was made by Mr Green in April.

Application 29 called YILTUN or YILKTAMA on Table Island. This was visited by Mr Green and the Agent in April last. It was found that the whole of Table Island was covered by the pre-emption records, but though there was an old Indian shack on the Island the old village site was on <sup>an</sup> Island called Ann Island lying at the north east corner of Table Island. It is recommended that the whole of Ann Island ( approx 15 acres) be set aside instead of Table Island. In the sketch it marked F  
= but the position is considerably westward of the mark on the sketch.

Nahkwookto Band

Re application No 31 Deserters Island. This is already a reserve being No 4 Mahpahkum.

I would recommend 5 acres at Kuthie application 35 instead of 32 Daliz or Taalts, being at the head of Frederick Sound Seymour Inlet.

KWANKEWLTH BAND.

It is noted that all the applications made by this band numbering from 36 to 58 inclusive have been rejected on account of the land being alienated.

Recently the Provincial Government had a survey made of most of Malcolm Island into 40 acre tracts. I have not a survey plat of the subdivision but would recommend as an alternative that 320 acres be given them with a frontage on salt water. In a recent map which however does not show the last survey sections 15 & 16 are only partially occupied and this amount could be obtained and a frontage on sections 13 & 14. This land lies near the west end of Malcolm Island. The soil is fair and suitable for agricultural purposes.

This band is very deficient in lands and this is urgently required.
