AN EXCURSION EXPRESS TRAIN leaves SARATOGA SPRINGS daily at 9.30 A. M., for LUZERNE and the UPPER HUDSON.

RETURNING leaves THE GLEN at 4.00 P. M., and LUZERNE at 4.55 P. M.

ACCOMMODATION TRAIN leaves THE GLEN at 8.00 A. M., returning leaves SARATOGA SPRINGS at 4.00 P. M., daily.

New French Coaches connect at THURMAN with Warrensburgh and Lake George.

LEAVITT's elegant Coaches connect at The Glen, with Chester, Pottersville, Schroon Lake and Minerva. From these last places Liveries can always be had to carry passengers to Long Lake, the Adirondacks, or the Raquette Lake.
