

Section 8

SIGNATURES ON TICKETS

All tickets must be signed in ink in the presence of the issuing agent, who must also sign his name as witness.

The head of a family traveling in company with those constituting same, in purchasing tickets may sign them, but only in the individual names of such members, upon the understanding that he will accompany them to destination and present the tickets in person to all conductors.

Ladies travelling alone, and children not accompanied by parent or guardian must sign their own names to all tickets, and proper care should be exercised to see that, when ladies are purchasing tickets, they sign their full Christian names. For example, Mary Black should not be permitted to sign her name as Miss Black or Miss M. Black, but Mary Black; likewise Mrs. Mary Black must sign her name Mary Black, not Mrs. Black or Mrs. James Black.

Tickets sold at fares quoted herein are non-transferable, and will be honored only for transportation of original purchasers.

TICKETS

Use regular form of tickets, reducing same to second class, and facing stub, contract and all coupons "settlers."

Section 10

BAGGAGE

Baggage will be checked from points on the Canadian Northern Railway and Duluth, Winnipeg & Pacific Railway under conditions shown in Canadian Northern Railway Local and Joint Tariff No. W. 98, I.C.C. No. 191, C.R.C. No. W. 1016, supplements thereto or reissues thereof and from points on lines of other participating carriers under conditions shown in tariffs of such lines as lawfully on file with the Interstate Commerce Commission and posted at such points.

Baggage may be checked to any point short of destination at which stopover is permitted.

DATES OF SALE

Tickets may be sold on March 9, 16, 23, 30 and April 6, 13, 20 and 27, 1915.

Section 12

CONNECTING LINES

Fares and arrangements authorized herein from Duluth are tendered connecting lines in the United States for basing purposes; they are **not** tendered Eastern Canadian lines for basing purposes.

Section 13

LIABILITY

In selling tickets and checking baggage under this tariff the issuing line acts only as agent and is not responsible beyond its own lines.

Section 14

ROUTES

Authorized routes are shown with destinations under railway lines on pages 3 to 7.

Section 15

OPTIONAL ROUTE

Tickets to Calgary, Alta. will be honored either via direct route or via Edmonton, Alta., and tickets to Edmonton will be honored via direct route or via Calgary. Tickets to Edmonton via Calgary or vice versa must be so faced.
