FOOD THAT DRIES THE MILK. A good cow will not be hurt in her milking by any of the ordinary foods in use, if given in moderation. But there are cows that will rather turn their food-into fat than into milk, and such cows may be tried by overleeding such strong food as commend or other grain. Bran will not be apt to dry a cow under any circumstances. a cow under any circumstances, thus it is a safer food than meal such cows as are apt to fatten when well fed. Every owner of cows should carefully test one to discover her character in this direction, for it is very true that a large proportion of cows kept do not pay for their feeding, and, of course, such cows are not profitable. More cows of this inferior kind for milk and butter will be found among the shorthorns and other breeds commonly fed for beef than among the special dairy breeds, as the Ayrshire, the Jersey, and the Holstein.
