Here are a few of its important points: It takes up little space, the design is of the inverted pattern, no water pump is necessary, the circulation around the jacket causes a natural flow of water. The chamber, water jackets, etc., is one piece. The crankshaft is enclosed in a case which carries the lubricators to the bearings, crankpins, etc. The crank dome cover can be removed independently of cylinder, the head of which is below the connecting rod, thus providing for inspection of piston and connecting rod, without dismantling the engine. The valve gear can be removed independently of cylinder, the head of which is below the connecting rod, thus providing for adjustment by means of a strap round the gudgeon and crankpins. Each down stroke gives an oil drip from the oil channel on each end of the connecting rod, thus supplying free lubrication. The bulk thereby falls into the piston trunk, where it is used. The fuel is controlled by an automatic inlet valve; once set by the regulator it requires no further attention. Magneto, coil, hot tube and automatic ignition can be fitted singly or as main and auxiliary systems, as per requirements of engine. If petrol is used, electric ignition avoids any delay for heating tube; after five minutes running of the engine the automatic timed ignition takes up the firing, being operated by a bulb, which becomes red hot and ignites the mixture at the correct moment by the plunger which admits fresh mixture to the bulb. It is of the four stroke type and runs 800 revolutions a minute.
