

SEA FOAM .- Whites of ten eggs beaten to a stiff froth, one and one half cups of sifted nour, one teaspoonful cream tartar; put into rings and bake quick.

COLD BEEFSTRAK PIE .- Cover a shallow dish with paste, and then spread on it a layer of steak cut in small pieces; season it well; cover it with paste and bake.

APPLE JELLY .- Boll till it becomes a perfect jelly one pound of moist sugar, one pound of apples, the juice of one lemon. Let it stand in a mould till quite firm and

DRIED APPLE CUSTARD PIE.—Put enough cooked apples through a sieve to make two pints; and milk to make it as thick as umpkin; four eggs; sweeten; make into tour pies.

SPICE CAKE.—One and a half cups butter, three cups sugar, one cup sour milk, five cups flour, five eggs, one teaspoon soda; cinnamon, cloves, nutmeg, allspice, each one teaspoon; one pound raisins.

LEMON PUDDING.—One pint of sweet cream; six eggs, beaten very light. Mix with the cream one large cup of sugar, grated rind of two large lemons, juice of one lemon. Line the dish with paste; pour the mixture in and bake.

FRUIT PIE.-One cup of sugar, one-half cup of butter, two eggs, one-half cup of sweet milk, two cups of flour, two teaspoon-fulz of baking powder. Bake in layers and spread thick with any kind of jam. Frost the sides and top.

CRAB APPLE JELLY.—Put the apples in a pan and mash well; then let them simmer in a preserving kettle twenty minutes; strain through a jelly bag, and to a pint of juice allow a pound of sugar; let it boil ten minutes and then pour into jars and place in a dark dark loce. dark, dry place.

APPLE MARMALADE.—Pare, core, and cut in small pieces any kind of sour apples, and to every pound put three-quarters of a pound of sugar; put them in a preserving pan and boil over a slow fire until they are reduced to a pulp; then put in jelly jars and keep in a cool place.

GREEN TOMATO CATSUP—One peck tomatoes, six pods red peppers, or one teaspoonful pulverized, four tablespoonfuls sait, four tablespoonfuls black pepper, one table spoonful of mustard, one tablespoonful ground cloves, one tablespoonful allspice, two quarts white wine vinerare, cook tomatoes and open. white wine vinegar; cook tomatoes and pep-pers in vinegar antil soft, then strain, auding all the spices, and boil slowly five hours, when cold, put in bottles and seal.

Gressen Courses and seal.

Gressen Crises - Two cups sugar, one cup butter, the rind and juice of one lemon; mix thoroughly, either with a spoon or with the hand, adding sufficient flour to make them 'hick mough to roll out, roll very thin and cut in small cakes with the catter; after placing in a pan rub the tops with leggs and sprinkle with white sugar; two eggs are enough for the tops of the cakes; they only require a few minutes to bake.

WAIERMELON CAKE. - White part. One and a half cups of sugar, one half cup of sweet milk, whites of three eggs, two tea-spoonfuls of baking powder, two rounding spoonfuls of baking powder, two rounding cups of flout. Ked part. One cup red sugar sand, one-half cup of milk, one-fourth cup of butter, yolks of three eggs, one cup of raisins chopped not too fine, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder, two cups of flour, to be baked in a large dish; put the red in the centre and the white around it.


