

Scientific and Useful.

SWEET peas will make finer plants if rooted in cool weather; therefore sow very early out of doors.

THE most severe cold or hoarseness may be relieved by applying to the chest, as quickly as possible, a flannel wrung out of boiling water, and on which turpentine is sprinkled.

FOR FELON.—Take equal parts of gum camphor, gum opium, castile soap and brown sugar; wet to a paste with spirits of turpentine. Prepare it and apply a thick plaster of it.

If any person who is liable to poison with poison ivy will take pure olive oil after being exposed to it he will feel no bad effects, and the oil will neutralize the evils of the poison if a few doses be taken even after the poison has broken out.

IN cleaning oilcloths never use either soap or hot water, soap causing the paint to come off, by dissolving the oil with which it was made. If very soiled rub briskly with lukewarm water and a soft cloth. When only slightly dirty a damp cloth should be rubbed over, followed by a dry one.

CHICKEN BROTH.—Cut up a large old fowl; put it in a gallon of water with one blade of mace, tea white pepper corns, one onion; simmer till the broth is half reduced; then heat a quarter of an ounce of sweet almonds and boil them in the broth; strain, and when cold remove the fat; serve warm with a little dry toast.

A LEMON PUDDING—May be quickly made by taking three tablespoonfuls of corn starch mixed with a little cold water. Pour boiling water into this, stirring until thick. Add one cup of white sugar, juice and pulp of two lemons, and the yolks of two eggs, and bake about half an hour. Beat up the whites and sweeten; brown in the oven.

CELERY SOUP. Boil a small cupful of rice in three pints of milk until it will pass through a sieve. Grate the white parts of three heads of celery on a bread grater; add this to the milk, after it has been strained. Put to it a quart of strong veal stock; let all boil together till the celery is very tender. Season with salt and cayenne pepper, and serve. Have dry toast cut in dice to add to it, if the persons like.

SNOWBALL CUSTARD.—Make a boiled custard, and when it is quite cold, put it into a deep glass dish. Beat to a stiff froth the whites of the four eggs that you omitted in the custard, adding eight drops of the oil of lemon. Take a tablespoonful of this froth and form it into balls of regular size and shape, dropping them on the top of the dish of custard. Do not let them touch one another. You may lay a leaf of a General Jacqueminot rose on the top of each ball if you choose.

A LIGHT PUDDING.—A light pudding is made of one pint of flour, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder, and a little salt, with milk enough to make a thin batter. Butter some cups and set them into the steamer, and put a large spoonful of the batter into each cup, and then a spoonful of jam; cover the jam with another spoonful of batter, and let the pudding steam for from twenty minutes to half an hour. Make a sauce of two eggs, a tablespoonful of butter, and one cup of sugar; beat them together, and pour over them one cup of boiling milk. This pudding is delicious with fresh fruit, berries or peaches.
