CONDITION OF THE MARKET.

TORONTO: The demand for lead pipe is fairly active. Prices for window glass are steady and the demand fair. By agreement the majority of American glass factories will cease operations for three months in order to prevent the accumulation of surplus stocks and consequent depreciation in prices. Paints and oils are very active. A drop of 1 cent per gallon has occurred in price of linseed oil and spirits of turpentine. Stocks of iron pipe are low, as also staple sizes of galvanized iron. The advance in price of spelter has stiffened prices of galvanized plates. Reports are current of violations of agreement as to prices on the part of some handlers of plate glass.

MONTREAL: The present season thus far has been a quiet one for cement. There is a fair demand for small lots. English brands are selling at \$1.80 to \$1.90 per barrel, ex-wharf. Fire bricks are in fair demand at prices ranging from \$16 to \$22 per 1,000. Turpentine has declined 42 cents per barrel. Linseed oil has also declined 1 cent per gal.
